


Morocco hit by devastating earthquake



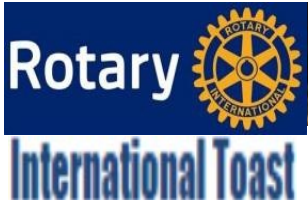
R.C. of Kippa-Ring North Lakes Donates to ShelterBox Responding to the Moroccan Earthquake Disaster Relief Effort

People in Morocco are feeling the effects of a devastating 6.8 magnitude earthquake that struck late on Friday night, 8th of September 2023, under the cover of darkness, when many people would have been at home asleep.

With the epicentre located 70km south of Marrakesh, it's the strongest earthquake ever recorded in the region. Initial reports suggest the worst affected areas are smaller mountain villages, closer to the epicentre of the earthquake, which will be hard to reach as roads are blocked by rubble.

According to the national authorities, 2,946 people died while the amount of injured people reached 5,674.
