1867-10-18 Alaska Purchase: US takes formal possession of Alaska from Russia, having paid \$7.2 million (roughly 2 cents an acre)

FF. Dutch explorer Willem Janszoon is believed to be the first European to land, see and map Australian soil. In 1606, Janszoon arrived on the West coast of Cape York Peninsula in Queensland. On his second voyage in 1618, he reportedly landed on the Western Australian coast, two years after Dirk Hartog made landfall on the island that now bears his name.
